INTRODUCTION

This brief presents an analysis of central government expenditure from January to April 2021. It also aims to inform Senior Management on the composition of total expenditure by different classification, highlighting the absorption capacity of different budget entities (BEs), and give an indication of expenditure trends compared to the same period a year earlier. It should be noted that all expenditure referred to in this brief is solely Government Local Fund (GLF), and the report does not factor any donor funds (loans and grants), including projects across the country.

TOTAL GOVERNMENT EXPENDITURE

Government's total expenditure as of end April 2021 amounted to **D6.5 Billion**, 29 percent more than what was spent during the same period last year.

Personnel Emolument (PE) and Other Recurrent (OC) collectively consumed 41 percent of total expenditure. Meanwhile, PE has increased from D1.34 billion to D1.47 billion, representing a growth of 9 percent.

In comparison to last year, Debt Service increased by 172 percent from D607 million to D1.65 billion, whilst expenditure on Development has increased by 57 percent.

Table 2 above compares the different budget classes against the 2021 approved budget, highlighting the absorption capacity by budget class. Development is the highest absorptive budget class, with 45 percent of its budget consumed as at end April 2021.

The different budget classes have collectively consumed 30 percent of the approved budget as at end April 2021.

Chart 1: Central Government Expenditure for End April 2021 compared to Approved budget, Source: IFMIS



Personnel Emolument increased by 9 percent relative to last year. Basic Salary constitutes 48 percent of total PE, and registered a growth of 5 percent, increasing from D664 million in 2020 to D699 million in 2021. Allowances have also increased by 17 percent as compared to the same period last year, from D571 million to D669 million.

The table above shows the approved budget for PE as compared to April 2021 expenditure. Basic Salary and Allowance have both consumed 31 percent of their respective approved budgets as at the period under review.

I. TOP TEN SPENDING BUDGET ENTITIES (BEs)

The top ten highest spending Budget Entities collectively consumed 87 percent of total expenditure as of end April 2021. Debt Service and Ministry of Works, Construction & Infrastructure registered as the highest spending ministries, consuming 25 and 15 percent of total expenditure respectively. The Ministry of Petroleum's expenditure has increased from 17 million in April 2020 to 138 million in April 2021, largely attributed to the D131 million paid as Land Compensation under the GERMIP project.

II. TOP TEN SPENDING BUDGET LINE

Service

Subvention, and Roads & Bridges registered as the highest expenditure line items, with 32 and 52 percent of their approved budgets spent as of end April 2021.

Meanwhile, Land compensation consumed 73 percent of its approved budget as of end April 2021, followed by the Settlement of Confirmed Debt and School Improvement Grant (SIG), both consuming 47 percent and 38 percent of their budgets respectively.
