PREPARED BY THE DIRECTORATE OF BUDGET

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INTRODUCTION

This brief presents an analysis of central government expenditure from January to March 2021. It also aims to inform Senior Management on the composition of total expenditure by different classification, highlighting the absorption capacity of different budget entities (BEs), and give an indication of expenditure trends compared to the same period a year earlier. It should be noted that all expenditure referred to in this brief is solely Government Local Fund (GLF), and the report does not factor any donor funds (loans and grants), including projects across the country.

TOTAL GOVERNMENT EXPENDITURE

Government's total expenditure as of end March 2021 amounted to **D3.8 Billion**, 5 percent less than what was spent during the same period last year.

Personnel Emolument (PE) and Other Recurrent (OC) collectively consumed 51 percent of total expenditure. Meanwhile, PE has increased from D988 million to D1.09billion, representing a growth of 10 percent.

In comparison to last year, Debt Service increased by 21 percent from D580 million to D700 million, whilst expenditure on Capital Development has decreased by 15 percent.

Table 2 above compares the different budget classes against the 2021 Approved budget, highlighting the absorption capacity by budget class. Capital development recorded the highest spending budget class, with 23 percent of its budget consumed as at end March 2021.

The different budget classes have collectively consumed 18 percent of the approved budget as at end March 2021.

Chart 1: Central Government Expenditure for End March 2021 compared to Approved budget, Source: IFMIS

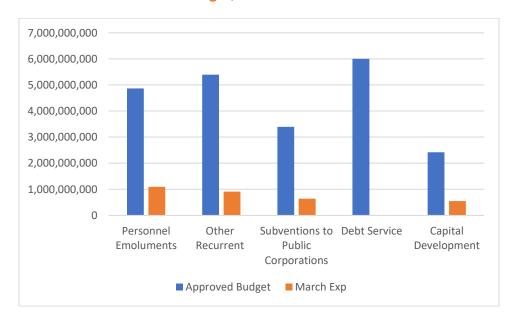

Personnel Emolument increased by 10.5 percent relative to last year. Basic Salary constitutes 47 percent of total PE, which registered a growth of 5.6 percent, increasing from D490 million in 2020 to D517 million in 2021. Allowances have also increased by 18.8 percent as compared to the same period last year, from D420 million to D499 million.

The table above shows the approved budget for PE as compared to March 2021 expenditure. Basic Salary and Allowance have both consumed 23 percent of their approved budgets respectively as at the period under review.

I. TOP TEN SPENDING BUDGET ENTITIES (BEs)

The top ten highest spending Budget Entities collectively consumed 85 percent of total expenditure as of end March 2021. Ministry of Basic and Secondary Education and Debt Service registered as the highest spending ministries, consuming 18 and 12 percent of total expenditure

respectively. The Ministry of Petroleum's expenditure has increased from 5.9 million in March 2020 to 136 million in March 2021 which is largely attributed to the payment made in the sum of 131 million under the GERMIP project.

The Ministry of Basic and Secondary Education expenditure has decreased by 7 percent from D750 million in March 2020 to D699 in March 2021.

II. TOP TEN SPENDING BUDGET LINE

Subvention, and Roads & Bridges registered as the highest expenditure line items, with 19 and 23 percent of their approved budgets spent as of end March 2021.

Welfare 10%

Meanwhile, Land compensation consumed 73 percent of its approved budget as of end March 2021, followed by Settlement of Confirmed Debt and School Improvement Grant (SIG), both consuming 29 and 38 percent of their budgets respectively.
